

## NEW JERSEY TRANSIT WILL CUT 200 JOBS



Officials at NJ Transit yesterday announced that they will lay off more than 200 workers and cut executive salaries by 5%. The executive salary of Director James Weinstein is included in the salary cuts; his salary will be reduced to \$248,257.80 from \$261,324. Layoffs will reduce the overall workforce at the agency by 2%. The agency will reduce its contributions to employees' 401(k) plans by one third and freeze spending. NJ Transit will save \$30 million; currently the agency faces a deficit of \$300 million by June 2011. The budget cuts are a part of New Jersey Governor Christie's plan to reduce state spending in the wake of a statewide budget deficit of \$2.2 billion.
