
PRINCIPALS, TEACHERS AMONG LAYOFF VICTIMS IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY



The Montgomery County Board of Education in Alabama unanimously approved a plan to cut 46 positions, which includes principals, teachers, bus drivers and a whole range of support staff. School employees affected by the cuts were to be notified Monday, Board attorney Ramadanah Jones told the *Montgomery Advertiser*. According to the report, more cuts are expected to follow. Superintendent Barbara Thompson said she plans to recommend cutting \$2 million in tenured staff positions later this year in an effort to close the district's \$18 million budget deficit.
