



THE US HASN'T HAD THIS MANY JOB OPENINGS SINCE 2008

U.S. employers posted the most job openings in four years in June, a positive sign that hiring may pick up. The data follow Friday's report that said employers in July added the most jobs in five months. A rise in openings could signal better hiring in the coming months. It typically takes one to three months to fill a job. Even with the increase, hiring is competitive.
