Connecticut's Greenwich Public Schools is seeking a new human resources director. Ellen Flanagan, the previous HR director, began as deputy schools superintendent two weeks ago. In the meantime, Regina Williams, assistant director of human resources, will act as interim director of human resources until the position is filled.
