

INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RESOURCES AND EXHIBITION CONFERENCE BEGINS IN DUBAI



The first-ever International Human Resources and Exhibition conference began Wednesday in Dubai. The event will last for two days and will be held at the Dubai International Convention and Exhibition Center. The Federal Authority for Government Human Resources (FAHR) will host the event, which hopes to answer questions regarding driving social economics for human resources professionals.
