

USC APPOINTS CHRIS BYRD VICE PRESIDENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES

After a nine month search, the University of Southern California (USC) has hired a new vice president for Human Resources. Chris Byrd, who is currently the director of Budgets and Human Resources for the school's Division of Information Technology, will take over as vice president of Human Resources on February 16.
