

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF GREEN BAY TO REVIEW VACANCIES AND TRANSFERS

One school district, the Green Bay School District, has plans to review the possible changes that could be made to the handbook for educators because of the concerns that were addressed by the School Board. School Board members expressed their concerns about a lack of information and details in the educator's handbook. Many of the different employees and members within the human resources department have talked about different changes that could be made, especially when it comes down to the way that the district chooses to fill in the vacancies left by teachers. However, the downfall to this is that any teacher that did not mention a specific position that is currently vacant available would not be allowed to apply for the position since it was not listed amongst their preferences of position. There are many people who disagree with these possible changes, saying that they are not fair for the teachers because at the time, a teacher many not be able to generally think of all the different positions he or she would be interested in at the very moment. The Green Bay Education Association delivered this argument as they believe it would not be fair to the different teachers. In fact, the executive director of the Green Bay Education Association, Keith Patt, says that with all of the work he does on a daily basis, 40 hours a week plus an additional 20 hours that he puts in each week, he cannot simply sit around thinking a
