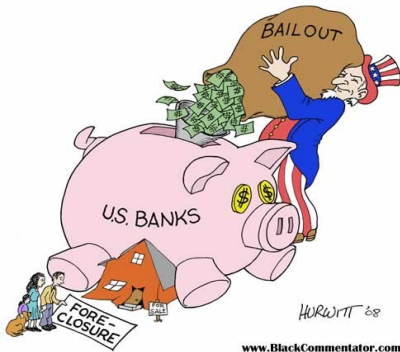


TOP EXECUTIVES AT BAILED OUT BANKS STILL EMPLOYED

At banks that are receiving federal bailout money nearly nine out of every 10 of the most senior executives from 2006 are still on the job, according to an Associated Press analysis of regulatory and company documents.

Nine out of 10 most senior executives at banks who are receiving bailout money are still employed, said an analysis of regulatory and company documents by the Associated Press.

It appears somewhat ironic as these are the same executives who were in control when the banking system just about collapsed. Top executives whose banks made risky loans that destroyed the economy haven't had their positions threatened, while a more unfortunate 100,000 bank employees were laid off during the past two years.
