



WHIRLPOOL TO CREATE 100 JOBS AT OHIO PLANT

Ohio Governor Ted Strickland applauded the announcement of a \$175 million investment by Whirlpool to integrate new energy-efficient automatic washer platforms, creating about 100 new jobs.
