

SABIC CUTTING 48 OHIO JOBS



Sabic Innovative Plastics has announced it is cutting 48 positions from its Washington, Ohio plant. Spokesperson Sheila Naab says the cuts are part of the company's global restructuring. Sabic eliminated 14 positions at the plant late last year, which it bought in September 2007 from General Electric Plastics.
