
DUPONT TO CUT 130 JOBS AT OHIO PLANT



DuPont will cut about 130 jobs at its plant in Circleville, Ohio. The town has a population of 13,500. The layoffs will leave the auto parts and consumer electronics plant with 400 workers, and will be completed in August. DuPont announced last week it **will cut 2,000** jobs, or 3.5% of its global workforce, as part of the company's restructuring plan. E. I. du Pont de Nemours & Company is an American chemical company founded in July 1802 as a gunpowder mill by Eleuthère Irénée du Pont. Wilmington, Delaware-based DuPont is currently the world's second largest chemical company.
