
NOKIA TO CUT ANOTHER 490 JOBS GLOBALLY



Helsinki's Nokia, the world's largest cellphone manufacturer, will cut a further 490 jobs globally, in addition to the **1,700 announced in March**. The Finnish firm will cut 170 jobs in logistics and production management & support, and will offer a voluntary resignation package for up to 320 employees working at its Salo plant in Finland. Nokia has cut 4,000 jobs globally this year.
