## SALT LAKE TRIBUNE HOLDS LAYOFFS

### **The Salt Lake Tribune**

*The Salt Lake Tribune* newspaper has eliminated three positions, as it restructures its newsroom. The paper laid off a graphic designer, a web technician and an administrative assistant to the Editor. The *Tribune* said new technology made the positions redundant. Severance is being offered. There are no plans for further newsroom layoffs at this time. Founded in 1871 as *The Mormon Tribune*, *The Salt Lake Tribune* is the largest-circulated daily newspaper in Salt Lake City, Utah. It is distributed by Newspaper Agency Corporation, which also distributes the *Deseret Morning News*. The Tribune is currently owned by the Denver's MediaNews Group.
