## DETROIT NEWS CUTTING 129 JOBS



The Detroit Media Partnership, which operates the *Detroit News* and *Detroit Free Press*, is laying off 129 workers, including editorial and management positions, as the US newspaper industry circles the drain. The firm blames the economic meltdown and a loss of ad revenue. Founded in 1987, the Detroit Media Partnership LP manages the business operations, including production, advertising and circulation, for the two leading Detroit newspapers: the *Detroit News* and *Detroit Free Press*. DNPS also handles Detroit-area circulation for the *New York Times*, *USA Today*, *Investor's Business Daily*, and *Financial Times*.
