The University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics will cut more than 200 jobs in fiscal 2010. The cuts will be made through through attrition, early retirements and layoffs, to trim \$45 million from the budget. UIHC employees 6,600 people. The University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics is a 762-bed public teaching hospital and level one trauma center affiliated with the University of Iowa. UIHC is part of University of Iowa Health Care, a partnership between the University of Iowa Roy J. and Lucille A. Carver College of Medicine and University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics.
