
COMPUTER CHIP HYBRID INTEGRATION PARTNERSHIP TO CREATE 675 NEW YORK JOBS



The State University of New York at Albany's College of Nanoscale Science & Engineering will construct a \$50 million computer chip packaging center, creating 200 jobs. The Computer Chip Hybrid Integration Partnership (CHIP) will also build a \$27.5 million computer chip commercialization center at the SUNY Institute of Technology outside Utica, creating 475 jobs.

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
