Gibbs in 1888 as the Electric Storage Battery Company, Milton, Georgia's Exide Technologies is the world's second-largest producer of automotive lead acid batteries for automotive and industrial applications. It has operations in 80 countries, and fiscal 2009 net sales of \$3.3 billion.
