Over the next decade, Geico will add 500 jobs to the Amherst center, which currently employs 2,000. The Government Employees Insurance Company, aka GEICO, is an American auto insurance company. Chevy Chase, Maryland-based GEICO is a wholly owned subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway, that as of 2007 provided coverage for more than 10 million motor vehicles owned by more than nine million policy holders.
