
50 CITY WORKERS IN OCEANSIDE FACING POSSIBLE LAYOFFS



The Oceanside City Council is set to vote on a proposal regarding spending cuts that would save the city \$7.2 million over two years. Up to 50 city workers are facing layoffs as the city faces a \$10 million deficit. The spending cuts were recommended by City Manager Peter Weiss. The layoffs are coming in response to a \$5 million dollar deficit. According to city councilman Jerry Kern, the situation is "pretty depressing."
