"This project strengthens our focus on renewable energy and new technologies that use waste as a resource." S4 Energy Solutions was formed in May 2009. It combines the PEM technology of InEnTec with Waste Management's experience in collecting and managing waste streams. Its goal is to double its renewable energy production to a energy equivalent of powering two million homes by 2020.
