

NEW JERSEY ADDS OVER 10,000 JOBS IN APRIL



Per the [Philadelphia Inquirer](#), New Jersey added 10,500 jobs in April. The information was published by the New Jersey Department of Workforce and Labor. Job findings occurred in both the public and private sectors. According to the Inquirer, unemployment numbers remained flat because many that have begun to look for jobs have still yet to find them and for statistical purposes, these job hunters are considered unemployed.
