
DALLAS GAINING JOBS WITH WIND TURBINE FACILITY



A Chinese wind turbine manufacturer inked a deal with the city of Dallas to build a new production facility that could bring up to 400 new jobs to the area. The *Dallas News* reports Guangdong Ming Yang Wind Power Industry Group Co. is working with the city to find a site for a facility that would build wind turbines. Managing director Wang Song said the company's Chinese plants usually employ between 200 and 400 workers. Guangdong will enter Dallas with a four-person staff that will be part of the company's North American and Latin American operations. Guangdong has more than 2,000 employees after starting in 2006 with just four, the *Dallas News* reports.
