

AUTO PARTS MAKER ADDING 230 JOBS IN NASHVILLE



LKQ Corp., a Chicago-based auto parts manufacturer, is bringing 230 new jobs to Nashville, Tenn. through the expansion of its corporate support facility at Grassmere Park, the Nashville Business Journal reports. According to the story, LKQ plans to add 15,000 square feet to its 35,000 square-foot office in Nashville. The company is hiring in the fields of accounting, information technology and payroll.
