

FINANCIAL COMPANY BRINGING 80 JOBS TO KANSAS CITY

Upromise, a Fortune 500 company, opened the call center July 12. It will have 35 employees by the end of the year and an annual payroll of \$1.5 million, company President Jeff Hawkins said at a ribbon-cutting ceremony. Most of the jobs at the call center will be in data processing and salaries will range from \$40,000 to \$100,000. Upromise Investments is a college savings program and is a subsidiary of SLM Corp., which is better known as Sallie Mae. Upromise Investments, which started in 2002, has more than 200 employees nationwide.
