AirTran opened a new command center in Orlando this week that will bring at least 120 new jobs to the area. The new Systems Operations Control Center will be used as a 24-hour command center for AirTran's entire airline. "Having 120 new jobs coming to the Sunshine State as a result of this expansion is everything that we're all about right now," said Crist.
