

## LABOR BOARD CASE COULD COST IOWA JOBS

According to Mitt Romney, Republican presidential candidate, the lawsuit filed by the National Labor Relations Board against Boeing could stifle jobs in Alcoa in Iowa, which provides materials for the airline manufacturer's 787 Dreamliner.
