

CITY HALL IMPROVEMENTS IN ST. LOUIS

A federal grand jury has charged the treasurer's office employee, Mr. Fred W. Robinson, with stealing more than two hundred thousand dollars from a charter school that was no longer in existence. Aside from being charged with stealing, he has also been charged with receiving more than \$30,000 a year for four years when he did not even show up for his job.
