There are still 2 million people living in California who are, unfortunately, still unemployed. Some people have been actively searching for work for several months, even nearly an entire year. Many of these people are even willing to do jobs that they normally would not apply for simply because they are in desperate need of work. And still, even with the struggle that they have had to deal with, many residents in the California area are still optimistic about finding work.
