

US RATE ON 30-YEAR MORTGAGE TICKS UP TO 3.52 PCT.

The article which is about the US rate on 30-year mortgage ticks up to 3.52 pct. To calculate average mortgage rates, Freddie Mac surveys lenders across the country on Monday through Wednesday each week. The average doesn't include extra fees, known as points, which most borrowers must pay to get the lowest rates. One point equals 1 percent of the loan amount.
