

## INDIA'S TATA POWER PLANS TO MAKE MORE PURCHASES ON WIND AND SOLAR

Tata Power in India is looking to acquire more investments in the renewable energy industry, focusing their efforts on wind and solar power. Last month, they bought a wind farm in Gujarat from the AES Corporation. The Tata group, an Indian conglomerate that specializes in practically everything, is the third largest utility company in the nation according to the Thomson Reuters India Index.
