The European human rights court rejected an invasion-of-privacy complaint by Princess Caroline of Monaco, one of two potentially groundbreaking rulings that uphold the media's right to report on celebrities. In both verdicts, the European Court of Human Rights based in Strasbourg referred to the often-tricky balance between the media's right to expression and an individual's right to privacy.
