



WHY YOU SHOULD USE THE ADVANCED SEARCH ON GRANTED FOR FINDING A JOB

Granted has many different ways for finding a job, including using the Advanced Search function. This allows you to search for specific criteria and details based on what you're looking for. While browsing through recently added jobs in your city or selecting categories is a great way to look, you might need to narrow down the search results. **Find More Jobs Suitable to Your Credentials** Many job postings include specifics about what they are or are not looking for in a job candidate. If you have a certain credential, degree or specialty, you can include that as one of the search terms in the Advanced Search, and find jobs fitting your qualifications. It helps weed out jobs looking for less or more experience than what you have. **Choose Different Words and Phrases** It also helps to use this function by selecting all of or part of different words or phrases. For longer keywords, you can search for individual words within the keyword, or for more important phrases, such as "entry level," you can select to use all of the wording exactly as it is. **You Can Enter Multiple Criteria** Another benefit to using the Advanced Search function on Granted is that you can enter multiple details with one click. This gives you an excellent response in jobs fitting the details you're looking for, such as choosing the location, different keywords and phrases, how many to display, how the results should be sorted, and the relevance. **View Recently Updated Listings** The last reason to use the [Advanced Search on Granted](#) when looking for jobs is because you can see the most recently updated job postings. You know when you are looking through these results and set it to see the last updated job first that you are seeing jobs that so far don't have as many applications. It increases your chance of being chosen for an interview.
