
SDUSD RESCINDS LAYOFF NOTICES TO MUSIC, ARTS TEACHERS



The San Diego Unified School District Board of Education voted to rescind layoff notices to music and arts teachers but more than 100 classified positions was rejected on a 4-1 vote, with board member Scott Barnett, who introduced the motion, casting the lone yes vote. Scott Barnett and Board Vice President John Lee Evans voted against the motion. Some of the money-saving measures presented were sell off some district property and raise the number of students in classes to 29 in each class.
