
LAYOFFS AT 4 N.J. NEWSPAPERS OWNED BY GANNETT



Gannett Co. slashed jobs at four newspapers owned by it. The job cuts were part of a continuing round of austerity measures implemented by the company and are the results of shifts in technology and readers opting to go online to do their reading.
