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SOLYNDRA LAYOFFS: BIGGER THAN EXPECTED



When Solyndra closed, it announced that it would be laying off around 1,100 employees, those who worked full-time for the company and those who were only temporary employees. However, it seems as though those figures were a little off, as there were actually approximately 1,861 employees who lost their job when the Solyndra Company, known for manufacturing solar panels, closed the doors on its business and basically stopped all operations. The information on the number of employees who were laid off came from the United States Labor Department. The documents showed that there were closer to 2,000 individuals who lost their job when the company shut down but aside from that, documents showed that back in 2011, showed that there were tasket to plot introduces there is the previous year, they still chose to increase the production of panels. When Solyndra finally closed back in August of 2011, the company had tons of inventories that had not been sold. In fact, Mitt Romeny stood in front of the factory just a month ago, talking about economic failure and how Solyndra was actually a symbol of that type of failure in this economy.
