

ATLANTA HOSPITAL CUTS 150 JOBS

Grady Health System*

Atlanta, Georgia's Grady Memorial Hospital has eliminated 150 jobs. The cuts affect non-clinical workers and senior management. The hospital system, which reported a \$37 million loss last year, blamed the cuts on declining reimbursements and the rising rolls of uninsured patients. Grady delivers more than \$250 million in free care per year. Grady, which employs about 5,000, has a long standing issue with its inability to collect patient medical bills.
