

HERSHEY SENDS 90 CALIFORNIA JOBS TO UTAH



Hershey's is shuttering its Redlands, California distribution center and sending the jobs to Utah. About 90 jobs will be lost. Hershey's, the nation's second-largest candymaker, opened the 600,000-square-foot distribution center in 2002. The company was bribed with a refundable tax credit to move the center to Ogden, Utah. The Hershey Company is the largest chocolate manufacturer in North America.
