

ILLINOIS COURT MAKING NONCOMPETE AGREEMENTS HARDER TO ENFORCE

A hearing in the Illinois Appellate Court, First District, ruled that a restrictive covenant signed by an employee was unenforceable. Finding that the restrictive covenant was insufficient, the court ruling could make it harder for employers to enforce restrictive agreements with their employees.
