



WHY DO BACKGROUND CHECKS?

Background checks provide companies with needed information about individuals' history, especially work history. These background checks also contain information about civil reports as well as a credit report, which can determine who may have been previously underemployed or might have a tendency to live beyond their means. However, criminal background checks can also be important for an employer hiring into positions with a significant risk of theft, and to avoid workplace violence. There are a number of conditions to verify before settling on a single background check provider. Another very important factor is the depth they research the individual. They should at least be able to verify educational credentials and provide proper academic records. They should have criminal records in detail, rather than charges which could mean practically anything. The absolute final deciding factor will probably be the turnaround time for receiving results, and the cost of the checks. Background checks can be costly and time consuming, but service providers try to compete and they are skilled enough to be able to report in a timely manner.
