

DALLAS MORNING NEWS LOSES 200 EMPLOYEES

The *Dallas Morning News* reduced its workforce by approximately 200 positions this week. The cuts occurred across the entire organization and affected every department. That includes associated companies, such as the *Denton Record-Chronicle, Al Día*, a Spanish-language publication; and DFW Printing. The cuts are part of an overall reduction of 500 positions at newpaper's parent company, AH Belo. The Dallas-based newspaper chain also owns *The Providence Journal* in Rhode Island and *The Press-Enterprise* of Riverside, California. As of the end of 2008, AH Belo had 2,950 full-time and 400 part-time employees. AH Belo cut 150 TV jobs in March.
