
CLARK COUNTY SCHOOLS MAY CUT 700 JOBS



Clark County School administrators are considering cutting 684 full-time Las Vegas-area positions next year. A \$2.1 billion spending plan will be considered for adoption by April 15th. Each Vegas school has been told to reduce staff by 3%, and administration must cut its budget by 12%. The nation's fifth-largest school district needs to cut \$120 million, on top of \$130 million in budget reductions already this year. The Nevada Legislature is still working on a state budget, so per-pupil funding won't be known until June.
