- 1. Surgeon (\$233,150)
- 2. Physician (\$187,200)
- 3. Psychiatrist (\$178,950)
- 4. Orthodontist (\$149,310)
- 5. Dentist (\$146,340)
- 6. Petroleum Engineer (\$130,280)
- 7. Air Traffic Controller (\$122,530)
- 8. Pharmacist (\$116,670)
- 9. Podiatrist (\$116,440)
- 10. Attorney (\$113,530)

The projected growth for these top 10 highest-paying jobs in America by 2022 is as follows:

- 1. Surgeon: 18 percent
- 2. Physician: 18 percent
- 3. Psychiatrist: 18 percent
- 4. Orthodontist: 16 percent
- 5. Dentist: 16 percent
- 6. Petroleum Engineer: 26 percent
- 7. Air Traffic Controller: 1 percent
- 8. Pharmacist: 14 percent
- 9. Podiatrist: 23 percent
- 10. Attorney: 10 percent
